Ned Temko, was our speaker at the International Council of Jewish Women’s Human Rights Day Seminar in December. He is a American journalist and newspaper editor who has worked much of his life in the United Kingdom. He discussed and debated with our members the reasons why the UK had voted for Brexit and Americans had voted for Donald Trump, and how he saw the press as a victim of the internet, since most people now read the news on electronic devices. ## What you should know about PayPal

**Data security:** PayPal's website is secure and encrypted and uses all of the same security features that you'd expect from any large financial institution.

**Your bank account and credit card numbers:** Using PayPal is arguably safer than giving your credit card number (or bank account information) directly to the website you're buying from; you can keep that information in one place – at PayPal – instead of spreading it around everywhere you shop.

You do not need to keep money in your PayPal account. You simply link a card or bank account to your PayPal account and pay instantly for online purchases.

**Disputes and fraud:** PayPal's Buyer Protection and Account Protection programs offer some protection against fraudulent transactions or seller disputes.
